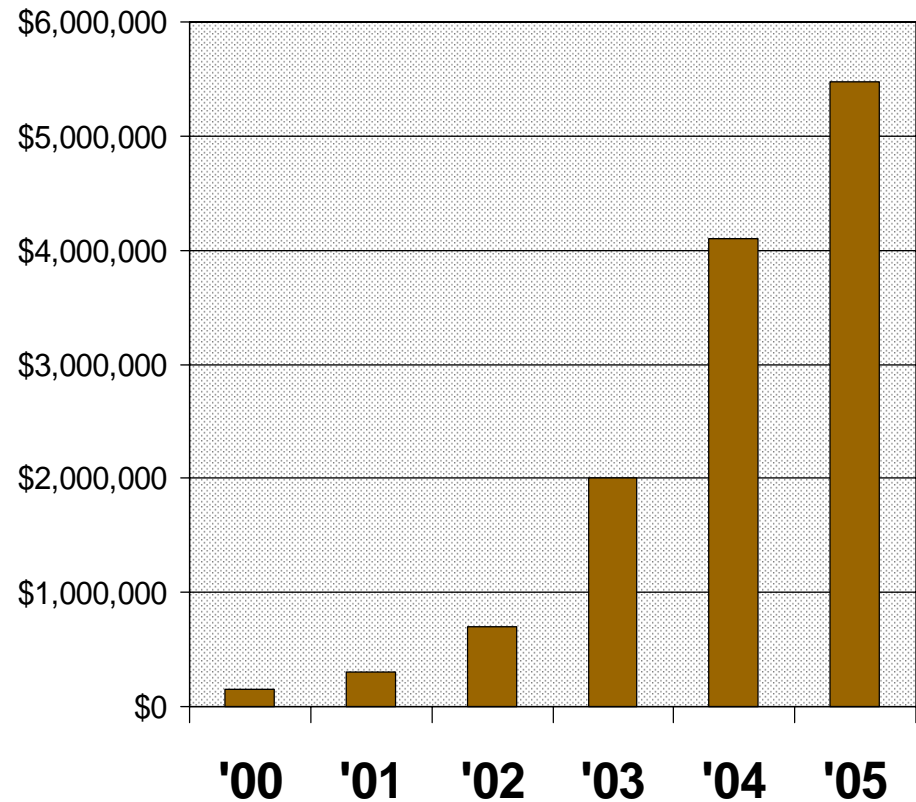


# NPS RM-CESU Fiscal Year 2005

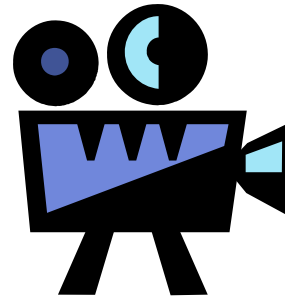
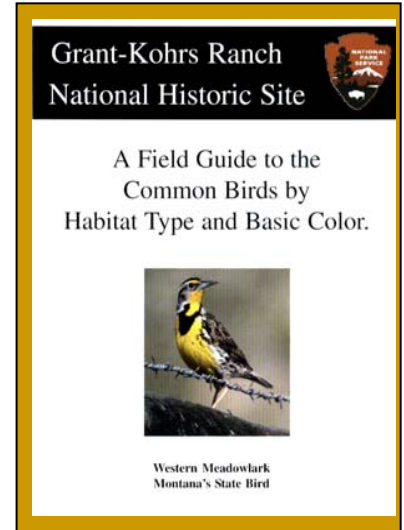


- By April 06, more than \$2 million in NPS project funds have been obligated – substantially earlier than in previous years
